Visit to the MAUSOLEUM OF ATATÜRK: Anıtkabir is the mausoleum of Mustafa Kemal Atatürk, the leader of the Turkish War of Independence and the founder and first President of the Republic of Turkey. Visit to the MUSUEM OF ANATOLIAN CIVILIZATIONS: The Museum of Anatolian Civilizations, which succeeded in winning the “European Museum of the Year” award in 1997, is one of the world's prominent museums with its distinctive collection including exhibits from every civilization that passed through Anatolia until the present-day arranged in a chronological order. The tour in the museum begins with the Paleolithic display case located on the left side of the entrance. The exhibits of gold, silver, glass, marble and bronze works date back as far as the second half of the first millennium BC.
