## ENBIS-14 Travel Information

Just 10 km outside Linz there is the "blue danube airport linz" IATA-Code LNZ:

There are scheduled flights from Frankfurt, London, Vienna (most important destinations) and many charter flights.

From the airport you may go to the central railway station with the Airport bus Linz (except on Sundays and holidays) - the trip takes 19 minutes and costs EUR 2,90:

A taxi from the Linz airport to the railway station costs approx. EUR 30 (to Hotel Schillerpark approx. EUR 35; to the Park Inn Hotel approx. EUR 40; to Hotel Goldener Adler approx. EUR 45; to Hotel Sommerhaus approx. EUR 55).

Participants may also fly to Vienna (<http://www.viennaairport.com/en/passengers>) and then travel to the Vienna railway station (Wien Westbahnhof) with the Vienna Airport Lines (one way ticket EUR 8; return ticket EUR 13):

From Wien Westbahnhof you may take the train to Linz either with ÖBB (enter "Wien West" in the From-field and "Linz/Donau Hbf" in the To-field to get a connection):

In the majority of cases it will be more convenient to fly to Linz - the flight is just slightly more expensive than the flight to Vienna and the trip from the Vienna airport to the Linz railway station takes at least 3 hours.
