

ENBIS-17: Final Call for Papers

ENBIS – the European Network for Business and Industrial Statistics – is a platform where statistical practitioners and academic statisticians from Europe and beyond meet, exchange ideas and design new projects. ENBIS sponsors an annual conference and numerous additional events, many of them web-based.

Our **annual conference** takes place every September and hosts presentations from a wide variety of sectors, ranging from manufacturing to service, from private to public.

The ENBIS-17 conference will take place in Naples (Italy) from 9th to 14th September 2017. It will be hosted by **the Department of Industrial Engineering at the University of Naples Federico II.**

The conference sessions are scheduled from 11th to 13th September, with the administrative meetings, the pre- and post-conference courses and workshops taking place on September 9th, 10th and 14th.



ENBIS-17 session topics include, but are not limited to the special areas of interest that exist within ENBIS (formalized in the so-called Special Interest Groups). The non-exhaustive list includes:

- Process Modelling and Control.

In addition to contributed sessions, ENBIS-17 includes 6 invited and 17 special sessions.

The **keynote addresses** will be given by **Arnoldo Frigessi** (University of Oslo, Norway) and **Paolo Nesi** (University of Florence, Italy). Arnoldo will talk on digital life and applications in big data health. Paolo will address big data challenges related to smart cities.

The keynote addresses will also be given by the 2017 Box Medalist **Jeff Wu** (Georgia Institute of Technology, USA), **Alberto Pisanisi** (EDF R&D and EIFER, Germany; recipient of the Best Manager Award) and **Antonio Canale** (University of Padua, Italy; recipient of the Young Statistician Award).

For the main event, our ENBIS-17 conference, this is the last call for abstract submission. We expect a maximum of 250 words by May 10th, 2017, at midnight.

Notifications of the acceptance of submissions will be sent out no later than June 1st, 2017. The early bird registration fee will be available up until June 19th, 2017.

Please note that due to the large number of tourists expected in Naples in September you should make your travel and accommodation arrangements earlier than usual so as not to face unexpected logistical and/or organisational constraints.
